

GUI terrible delay AT

Hi guys, having some strange problem.

During the first run the GUI of EVE reacts to mouse clicks of the bot instantly but after setting some things and starting the bot in normal mode it gets some crazy delays. It clicks market for example and there is like 2 sec gap between the click and the actual reaction from the game.

I wouldn't mind about that but I can see bot gets into trouble sometimes like when it tries to adjust some windows sizes - he cant for example manage to grab the edge like he would be doing it waaay to fast which he isn't.

Did anyone already noticed such behavior? Any solutions? I'm testing some mouse click delay atm which seems to solve the problem but this rather seems like a poor solution in the long run.

Are you talking about virtual machine? If so try to use VM7. Current VM may be downgraded to 7th version. Deinstall VMWare Tools and install them from 7th version.

Did you create virtual machine using old VM?

Can you check another idea? I dont have mouse lag and cannot check this easily. Install teamviewer into VM. Activate option to leave VM running when workstation is closed in workstation settings. Connect to VM via teamviewer and close workstation. I believe TV will show desktop in this case. Start bot and check for mouse lag.

Now I can see that after few days of botting (its my first experience with the bot since like 2 years - meanwhile I changed computer to very fast gaming machine so its not the hardware fault nor the internet connection due to a fact that if I launch game manually from Launcher all seems good - all the time talking about VM) the Market needs like 10-15 seconds to load ich window with data ;(I got no idea what the hell.

I got a major question.
As I can see drastic difference in performance between EVE launched by the bot and EVE launched by me manually on the same VM I would like to ask what is the difference between those 2 instances?
Does bot pass some extra parameters? If yes I suspect that they do not work great for me. Is it possible to force bot launching the bot without these?

Check shared settings -> error correction -> dx9 mode, no console. Bot will start eve differently.

I doubt it is starting eve thing. EP records screens quite frequently. You may try start eve with launcher, open test stand (in tools). Lock it to eve. In bmp extractor edit the number of screens to take to be 100 and click start. If eve start to lag, it is hardware compatibility.

EDIT: Checked your video. No ideas what is this. Try to pause bot with control + p and check for a lag again.

DX9 mode changes nothing.

BMP Extractor did NOT made lags in the game.

Any other ideas? I rather got a strong gaming setup for 3k EUR so it would be strange if it would be the problem.

P.S Yeah I checked if lag exist during the BMP Extractor working (before DONE communicate) and after, no issue.

If you pause bot you stop all the activity of EP. Try to disable built-in videocard in BIOS of a host. Switch ON/OFF CPU virtualization support in BIOS also.

Without virtualization I cant fire up the VM at all. I tried reinstalling setting different modes for the procesor in VM settings and nothing seems to work to turn that thing on. I reinstalled the whole VM and tried VM11 and VM7, no luck.

I get this:
